DATA PROTECTION:

It is necessary for LES Great Britain and Ireland (“LES”) to collect and record certain personal data relating to each member, including their name, address, e-mail address and academic qualifications. The personal data about each member may be used for administration, management and marketing to include, but not limited to, publication in the directory of members both LES Britain & Ireland and of LES International, transfer to LESI in the United States for general membership purposes and to enable inclusion of name, address, telephone, fax and email details on the LES website and in the annual membership CD ROM (and hard back version) and for providing members’ details to third parties pursuant to a decision of LES that it is beneficial to do so for defined marketing reasons.

LES wishes to ensure that each of its members (for the purposes of applicable data protection legislation) explicitly and unambiguously consents to the processing of personal data by LES in conjunction with its ordinary business. Therefore, each member should indicate ONE of the following:

- I consent to the use of my membership details as set out above and for such purposes as LES consider reasonable and appropriate including, but not limited, to the processing of my renewal and the circulation of information to me from time to time.

OR

- I consent to the use of my membership details as set out above provided such is restricted only to publication and circulation to LES members (i.e. is not given to any third parties).

Please note that if you do not express a choice, LES will assume you have accepted the first of the above options.

Each member has the right to request in writing a copy of any personal data about themselves which is held on database by LES and have amended any personal data which is incorrect, incomplete or misleading.
